The Hospital's **MOBILE WELLNESS PROGRAM** provides all-digital mammography screenings and follow-up services year-round for about 1,200 women who are under- and uninsured. For eligible women, screenings are made possible thanks to grants from the Breast Cancer Alliance, Inc., Susan G. Komen for the Cure, CT Affiliate and the Paint the Town Pink campaign. The Hospital is a member of the Connecticut Breast & Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program, which is funded by the State Department of Public Health and Centers for Disease Control & Prevention.
